The Accreditation Council for Entrepreneurial and Engaged Universities (ACEEU) is the only globally-operating quality assurance body with a focus on acknowledging (community) engagement and entrepreneurship in Higher Education. We shape the future of higher education by (1) independently evaluating the university performance, and (2) celebrating the university achievements for international recognition in entrepreneurship and engagement.

Next to accreditation, we are driving knowledge generation and implementation through more than 30 EU-funded projects that we are currently conducting in cooperation with 200+ international partners from 35+ countries. The projects cover entrepreneurship, community engagement, digitalisation, sustainability and innovation in higher education.

Due to an influx of projects, we are hiring two **International Project Officers**. The positions are open until filled.

Your main tasks will be to

- Execute projects on the topic of *higher education and digitalisation or entrepreneurship* in an independent, autonomous way reaching high quality standards (incl. communication with international partners, research work, analysis and creation of reports, organisation of events and attendance of meetings, presentation and dissemination of results). - Represent ACEEU and your projects in international project meetings and training programmes (around 8 to 12 international trips can be expected during the year)
- Contribute to the development of new project proposals in digitalisation or entrepreneurship in higher education, both independently and as part of a team
- Get creative and develop your own "ACEEU 5% project" as a way to immerse yourself in other areas of the company and get new knowledge and inspiration
- Develop your own style of team work that fits to the group dynamics

What we look for is

A good addition to our team relies on being dynamic, entrepreneurial, autonomous, innovative and creative. You should feel comfortable with being busy and spontaneous in a fast-growing start-up/scale-up. Our plans can change depending on what new opportunities arise: new acquired projects and new initiatives are a good example of that, so being able to move fast, adapt and contribute is key. It is a unique learning and professional development experience that requires effort and dedication. You need to be ready to find solutions and be comfortable with challenges. You will benefit from bringing your background knowledge and skills to create innovative initiatives and solve challenges.

Who you will work with
